## **Fresno Vet Center Announces Open House**

FRESNO, Calif. – The Fresno Vet Center invites Veterans, family members, friends, Veteran Service Organizations and community partners for an Open House on Sept. 11, 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at 1320 E. Shaw Ave., suite 125.

About 500 Veterans are currently receiving counseling and therapy through the Fresno Vet Center, staffed with one Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist, five Social Workers and three Administrative Employees.

Vet Centers across the country provide a broad range of counseling, outreach, and referral services to combat Veterans and their families.

Vet Centers guide Veterans and their families through many of the major adjustments in lifestyle that often occur after a Veteran returns from combat.

Services for a Veteran may include individual and group counseling in areas such as Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), alcohol and drug assessment, and suicide prevention referrals.

All services are free of cost and are strictly confidential.
